**Prizes:** This time in the 4<sup>th</sup> Medical Olympiad we are proud to announce prizes to be awarded to two distinguish colleagues: Dr. Anastasios Tousimis, from Maryland in honour of his prototype multiple scientific contribution in Medicine for more than 60 years, and to: Dr. George Sfakianakis from Florida in honour of his prototype multiple scientific contribution in Medicine.

Both these two prizes will be gold plated medals, accompanied by a diploma and a souvenir.

As in all previous Olympiads, three prizes will be awarded to the three best papers among all and will be accompanied by a diploma and a gift.

In the 4<sup>th</sup> Olympiad *for the first time will be another contest*. The three best winners of this contest will be the ones to give the best answers to 3 existing medical problems-questions. There will be three winners who shall receive a diploma and a gift. These questions are mentioned below. In ancient Olympics, there was a similar contest and prizes. We know that similar medical contests were held in Ancient Olympics in the city of Efessos, Asia Minor and in other ancient Greek cities. One of the questions asked in Efessos was: *What you may diagnose in a patient with very pale face, weakness etc. and what you will suggest for treatment.* 

The three questions to be answered refer to the following subjects: Please be concise and use references when needed. State what is still unknown. Deadline for submission of answers: October 9<sup>th</sup> 2017. As mentioned below, registration fee covers only submission of papers.

For replies to the three questions the fee is 100 euros. Those who shall reply to these questions can either attend the meeting and submit their answers or submit their answers by post or by email.

**Subject 1.** A 40 years old healthy man feels very tired after intense physical exercise for 3km.

**Questions:** a) Please give the complete definition of fatigue. Describe findings in serum and effects in the respiratory, cardiovascular, tendomuscular and nervous systems.

b) This man after exercise lies in bed. When you expect that this man will be completely rested? Describe rest as opposite to the above findings of fatigue.

**Subject 2.** A male patient 50 years old with an intense back pain for sometime has a heavy headache, a flash on his face and a warm and heavy head. His blood pressure, heart beats and respiration are normal.

Questions: Can you support or reject the following?: a) The brain secretes endorphins or/and other substances in response to severe pain. If so, what is the normal serum level of endorphins and other hormones or hormone-like substances that may be released in response to severe pain? Is there a threshold for the duration and for the severity of pain before the above hormones or hormone-like substances are excreted in serum? If severe pain last for long, is there a plateau of the above secretions in serum?

b) Does brain response to intense pain have a direct impact to heart rate and respiration? By what mechanism? Please describe.

**Subject 3.** The director of a very busy factory, a 50 years old healthy man, asks his physician for: a) the best location for his summer holidays and b) how long is best his holidays to last.

**Questions**: If you were the physician would you suggest: a) a place at sea level, at 200m height, or 400m height and why and b) for how long the summer holidays must last in order to offer better health to the director?

**Instructions for Abstracts.** Abstracts may be up to one and a half A4 page long, with borders of 2cm around the text and 1.5 distance between the lines, written in Times New Roman letters size 12, at any format, preferably the format of the Hell. J. Nucl. Med., http://nuclmed.web.auth.gr. Abstracts and all the whole papers may be published after the authors' consent, in the supplement of HJNM, IF. 1.015. **Deadline** for submitting detailed abstracts or the complete papers or the answers to the Three Questions is **Monday October 9**, 2017.

**Criteria for the evaluation of papers** *have been*: a) Originality on a new subject-basis: 40%, or on an existing concept: 30%, b) Social impact: 25%, c) Statistical support or sufficient proof of results: 25%, d) Typical and simple presentation: 10%.

The final programme-booklet will be distributed to the participants who register in the Olympiad. This booklet shall include: a) all necessary and additional information for the 4<sup>rth</sup> Olympiad, b) the abstracts of all papers orally presented and 2 questions and their answers given by the authors, c) answers to the Three Questions.

**There will be only one invited distinguished lecture** on Friday evening on the 3<sup>th</sup> of November 2017 by Professor Afxendios Kalagkos about "Recent advances in surgery in congenital cardiac diseases. Contribution to non privileged children".

Round tables, other lectures or posters are not allowed in the Olympiads.

The Chairpersons of every session may have a few minutes to introduce the speakers. For every paper to be presented, at least *one author should be registered. The time allowed for every orally presented paper will be 15min and for discussion 5min. Authors are kindly requested to comply with this timetable. For more information please contact us at the e-mail address of the Association.*
